Corinth Hills in Trinidad.
There were over 700 homes
being built by the
government for low income
families. A visiting team
helped us there with a week
of meetings to teach the
Gospel. Over twenty people
asked Jesus to be their
Savior. Sanchez was one of
them. He was about twelve
years old. He invited several
friends to also come to the
night meetings.

“Sanchez loves Jesus a lot,
and prays a lot for his father
who is not a Christian.
Sanchez’s father lives on
another island. Sanchez lives
with his mother and her
friend. Sanchez has
challenges and needs
encouragement and prayers,
too. He may become a leader
one day. Please pray for
guidance for him.”

people they needed to pray
for, too.

The steel drum was invented in Trinidad.

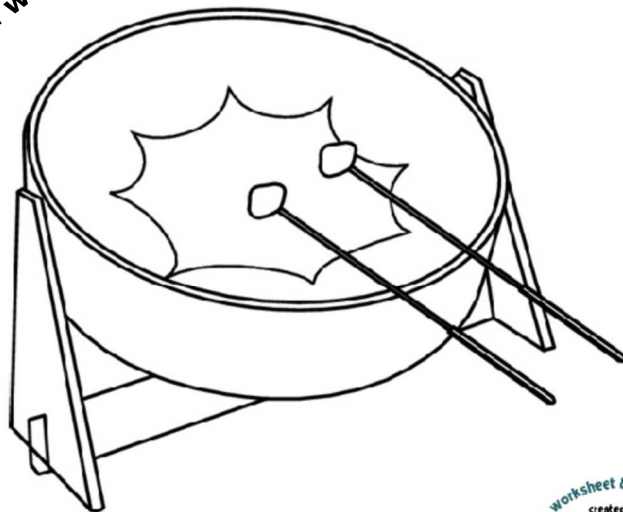

* Can you guess where the name Caribbean comes from?

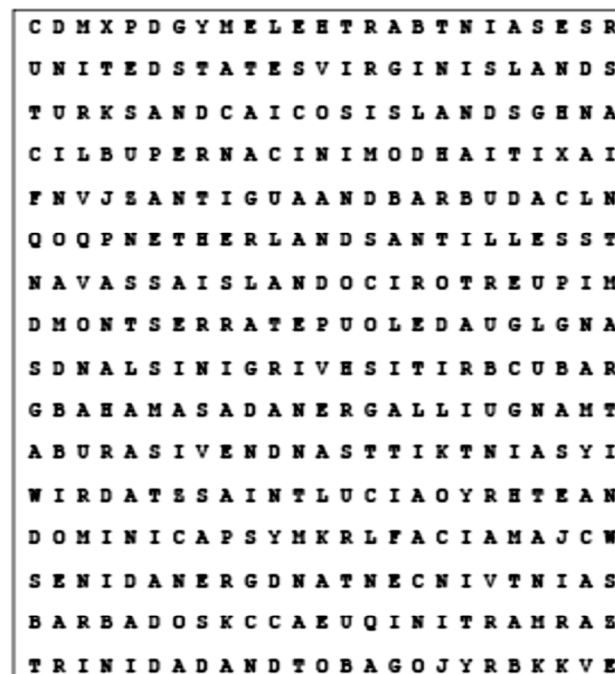
The official language of Trinidad and Tobago is English, not Spanish.
