
she met her mother.

Mr. Yogi smiled at the children. "Would you like to hear another story about prayer?" he asked.


"YES!" they all answered.

"Every Sunday Sanchez would go from house to house, whistling and knocking on doors and windows. He would call people on his cell phone to get them ready for Sunday worship.

"In that way God answered my prayer for a church to start in Corinth Hills.

"Sanchez loves Jesus a lot. and prays a lot for his father who is not a Christian. Sanchez's father lives on another island. Sanchez lives with his mother and her friend. Sanchez has challenges and needs encouragement and prayers, too. He may become a leader one day. Please pray for guidance for him."


After this story, the children sat quietly, thinking about people they needed to pray for, too.
