Upon entering your exercise class, your friends shed their hijabs and you hear three different dialects from three different islands being spoken in a little room. Your heart bounces between heartache and joy.

Inexpressible heartache because you know these languages represent three of the hundreds of unreached people groups of your country. Unspeakable joy because you have the privilege of calling these ladies friends.

This is the reality of “city” life on our island. Many years ago, a government decision was made to send people from the more densely populated areas of the country to the less populated islands. Although the answer you would hear as to why this was decided would vary depending on who you ask, we are convinced God has His own reasons for sending these beautiful people here.

God's Plan

We are convinced God has a plan for these people who represent numerous unreached people groups from this largely Muslim country.

We believe this is a unique opportunity found in few places, as migrants tend to be more open to new ideas and beliefs as they are removed from all that is familiar.

Ultimately, we believe God is moving these people so that they can hear the gospel, learn what it means to be a part of the church, and spread this message both here and through their home villages —places that are often hard for foreigners to enter.

Today, Southeast Asia is being deeply impacted by the transmigration of people within the area. Migrants represent a variety of ethnic groups and religious backgrounds, Islam being the largest.

From at least the tenth century, Muslims were trading in Southeast Asia. By the thirteenth century, Islamic teachings began to spread throughout the region.

Even with this long history, we rejoice that God is now using migration to open new doors for the gospel.
