What is this trip?

A fresh wind of faith is needed in Western Europe today. Come to France and explore the challenges of sharing the gospel in a place where secularism reigns and the Bible is seen as a thing of the past. Engage people who no longer believe that God exists while you learn from missionaries experienced in communicating truth in a post-Christian climate.

Explore your long-term calling by going short-term.

Learn more about yourself while using your gifts and talents in an environment different from you own. Learn more about the world as you worship with and serve alongside people in Paris and it's suburbs.

World Team France internships give you maximum hands-on experience in cross-cultural ministry while furthering long-term church-planting efforts. And you'll experience life-on-life discipleship by a mentor.

What is this field/ministry?

A multi-cultural team of North American and European workers and French church leaders, form a team known as France VIE. This is a play on words, "VIE" which means life, yet the initials stand for "a vision to plant churches."

France VIE has joined the evangelical community in their vision to see one church for every 10,000 people in the country. The greater Paris area has one church for every 50,000 inhabitants. Overall, France has an average of one church per 38,000 inhabitants. Our Godsized vision is to have a church for every 10,000 people.

What will I do?

Week 1: Orientation, discipleship

Week 2: Hands-on ministry

Week 3: Paris Prayer Connection – opportunity to visit a number of our church plants to connect with teams and pray.

Eligibility

Candidates should be Christians with an interest in cross-cultural ministry and have at least one year of post-high school study. Qualities such as flexibility and humility are vital to cross-cultural life and ministry.
