An INN Internship will help you learn more about yourself while using your gifts and talents in an environment different from your own. And, learn more about the world as you serve people from different cultures and world religions.

Internships provide you with hands-on experience in cross-cultural ministry while furthering long-term church-planting efforts.

What is this ministry?

The INN (International Neighborhood Network) envisions a world where the hope of Jesus is transforming communities among all peoples, starting with the nations in our backyard.

Our passion is to see the gospel proclaimed in cities where there is little to no gospel witness among unreached people groups that have found refuge in the US.

What will I do?

First Week: Orientation, Introduction to the Community and Training

Middle Weeks: Hands-on ministry, Training and Mentoring

Final Week: Debrief and Next Steps

Eligibility

Candidates should be Christians with an interest in cross-cultural ministry and have at least one year of post-high school study. Qualities such as flexibility and humility are vital to cross-cultural life and ministry.
