What is this field/ministry?

World Team has been serving in Cameroon for over 30 years. It's been a long work, but there are glimpses of changed lives because of the goodness of the Lord and the perseverance of His saints. This ministry uses many different avenues to accomplish the proclamation of God's Word. We use chronological oral Bible storying as a training tool for raising up leaders among this oral society and focus on small groups of men, women, youth, and children. It is also a high value that we raise up leaders from among the Baka people to lead the churches that are being planted. The Baka are often passed over for more educated people but the Baka should know that they are also highly loved and are able to be equipped through God's strength to lead others to the knowledge of Jesus Christ.

What is this trip?

You will be serving on the field with seasoned church planters who are dedicated to raising up church leaders from the local population.

Interns will partner in a ministry focused on leading classes of primarily non-English speaking athletes of various ages. It is expected that the intern is able to properly demonstrate athletic movements and assist others in achieving the proper movements as well. Many of the students that initially participated in this program are now regular attendees of the local youth ministry. The goal is to provide a gospel presence as we interact with the participants. God's Word is shared with athletes and spectators at every class and during competitions.

What will I do?

- Help in sharing the gospel with the athletes that attend the fitness center classes
- Create competitions between athletes of varying ages
- Participate in day-to-day tasks at the remote camp where you will live

Eligibility

Candidates should be Christians with an interest in cross-cultural ministry and have at least one year of post-high school study. Qualities such as flexibility and humility are vital to cross-cultural life and ministry. You will need open eyes, a servant heart, and the courage to engage with people from cultures other than your own.
