Diaspora Muslim Ministry in the Triple Frontier Region

By the Numbers

- There are 35,000 Muslims in Ciudad del Este, with numbers growing through immigration and conversion
- Less than 1% are believers
- Ciudad del Este is the largest city within the Triple Frontier region, which borders Foz do Iguacu, Brazil and Puerto Iguazú, Argentina

Spread of Islam

It is clear that Islam is growing in Latin America and that this growth has been recognized and promoted by Islamic leaders in the Middle East. According to local experts, Muslims have a clear agenda in Central and South America.

Recent reports of five evangelical pastors converting to Islam and becoming Imams, as well as many other Latins converting to Islam, is a growing concern. Islam is also drawing and engaging the younger generation of Paraguayans as seekers attend the Mosque and convert to Islam.

Muslim communities have integrated themselves into national activities, standing out for their hard work, respect, and love for the country that sheltered them. Many of them have grouped together to create Islamic societies, centers, mosques, etc., so that they can worship freely. Currently, in all Latin American countries, there are Muslim concentrations, immigrants, and natives, who adopted Islam as their new faith.

Today, members of the Latin Muslim community participate in Islamic congresses around the world. Some young Latin Muslims study at universities in Arab countries, while others express a desire to have increased knowledge about Islam, even as they maintain their Islamic religion and traditions.

Location

Ciudad del Este is the second-largest city in Paraguay and is situated on the Paraná River. It is located 327 km from Asunción, the capital, and is adjacent to the border with Brazil, to which it is connected by the Friendship Bridge on the Paraná River.

Important to the spread of the gospel is that this is the largest city within the Triple Frontier region. Ciudad del Este is a commercial city and is one of the largest free trade zones in the world. Its tax-free status attracts many Brazilians and Argentines to the city.

The city has a growing population through immigration and the conversion of Latin Americans to Islam. There are tens of thousands more Muslims located across the bridge into Brazil and to the south in Argentina. Ciudad del Este is a pivotal gateway to establishing and expanding Muslim ministry in south central South America.
