What is this field/ministry?

Each World Team field has a unique approach to engaging within its own context, but the desires are the same: introduce people to Jesus, disciple them, and release them into ministry. Visiting multiple mission fields will help you understand that the same gospel is proclaimed through various strategies. You will see how different histories and cultures lead to different ministry methods. The gospel first came to this continent almost two thousand years ago, but Europe needs people and churches that can once again make known the good news of God's love offered freely in Jesus.

What is this trip?

This trip is a unique opportunity to experience a variety of church plants and learn from different missionaries. Interns will learn about the spiritual climate and culture, work alongside experienced church planters, and engage with locals. Interns will begin in the 15th District of Paris, then travel to Madrid, Spain, and finally to Chisinau, Moldova. Interns will then return to Paris for a debrief.

What will I do?

- Be mentored by experienced church planters
- Paris: Take part in grassroots neighborhood outreaches, including caring for flower beds, cleaning up trash, handing out water, and participating in an English Café
- Participate in the WT Spain prayer week by traveling to multiple church plants, learning, and praying
- Madrid: Help church planters deepen relationships through various activities, including sports tournaments, kids' day camps, English events, and a food/clothing bank for immigrants
- Chisinau: Serve as counselors for a kids' English Day Camp. Help lead camp worship songs, teach English vocabulary, and even run through the forest dressed as pirates!

Eligibility

Candidates should be Christians with an interest in cross-cultural ministry and have at least one year of post-high school study. Qualities such as flexibility and humility are vital to cross-cultural life and ministry. You will need open eyes, a servant heart, and the courage to engage with people from cultures other than your own.
