**Opportunity** Join a church planting team near Manila, serving through admin, tech, and relational ministry across multiple church and ministry sites.

## What is this trip?

Interns will be involved in relational ministry—visiting and observing local churches, church plants, and Bible studies. They will have opportunities for personal and ministry growth. Interns will assist with administrative and technical tasks, such as organizing documents, supporting media and communication efforts, and helping improve systems that strengthen the ministry's reach. There will be opportunities for producing videos and training projects.

## What will I do?

- Attend weekly team meetings and participate in discipleship gatherings, worship services, outreach events, and mentoring times
- Contribute to children's ministry, evangelistic outreach and/or training and retreat events
- Live with a missionary family and become part of the life of the team and local churches
- Grow in your understanding of biblical missions, develop cross-cultural friendships, and contribute meaningfully to church planting efforts in the Philippines

## What is this field/ministry?

Team OASIS serves in Antipolo, Rizal—just outside Metro Manila—planting confessional churches through proclamation, discipleship, and long-term relationship-building. The team has planted several churches and has an emerging Bible study in Sun Valley. The ministry focuses on evangelism, discipleship, and establishing healthy, self-governing local churches grounded in the ordinary means of grace. Interns will serve on a team comprising an American family and two Filipino families, gaining firsthand experience in a multi-site, cross-cultural church planting environment.

The team in Antipolo has been blending solid theological foundations with flexible, culturally sensitive strategies in both urban and marginalized communities for more than a decade. We have prenatal and community clinics, kids programs, livelihood projects, marriage counseling, and several Bible studies. Our current main focus is training and developing elders, producing church materials, and evangelizing in new locations.
